- Q. Let me know when you are there.
- A. I am there.
- Q. I am trying to understand the explanation that is provided with respect to decibels that will be during the construction phase and how that compares to what was considered to be the normal pre-construction levels that were identified.

And if I understand correctly your testimony indicates that the construction levels are going to be between 32 and 58 decibels.

- A. Correct.
- Q. And when I look at Mr. Chadha's testimony it seems to indicate, and tell me whether I am wrong, that the pre-construction would be between 42 decibels to 68 decibels. I am looking specifically to his response on Question 6.
 - A. On page 2?
- Q. Yes, page 2. But then during construction the levels would go between 32 and 58 decibels. So, I don't understand how construction could actually be fewer decibels than pre-construction.

A. If I am correct in how I am interpreting that, I don't believe it's the ambient levels during construction. I think it's the actual noise levels that the construction activity will present.

So, in other words, it would be how loud is the dozer, how loud is the, you know, some of the construction activities during the actual sound of those and what that is measured at. So it won't be actual ambient existing conditions. It will be construction noise essentially.

- Q. But doesn't his testimony state that the ambient sound levels surrounding the facility site --
 - A. Is 42 to 68.

2.1

- Q. But that is before construction?
- A. Correct. So during construction I think what he is saying here, and we can clarify this after this, but what I think he is saying is that just will actually be the sound of construction equipment makes itself. I don't think it's a measure of that sound of the construction activity in the environment, in the existing environment. I don't think he

is comparing it to say there is construction activity in this neighborhood and the ambient existing sound is this, and the construction sound is going to add to it or is going to supplement.

2.1

I think he is just saying that actual sound of that equipment presents. I don't think I am explaning this right, or helping.

- Q. That is why I am confused because to me it sounds like he is saying that the baseline is 42 to 68 and then construction will be, the actual level will be about 32 and 58.
- A. I understand what you are asking.

 And I think I am not explaining -- if I

 understand correctly what he is trying to say, I

 think he is saying the 42 to 68 is preexisting

 current ambient conditions.

So you are standing out there with construction, no other noise, that is what you hear. But, I don't think it's the same direct relationship. I think he is saying that 32-58 decibels is what the construction activity and the construction equipment is going to generate.

So I still think it's going to be -you are still going to have the 42 to 68

decibels out there during construction. I don't think he is indicating that we are going to lower the actual existing sound here.

If I understand noise correctly, it's just the highest level is what you hear. So it's not supplementary. So I think he is just saying that is the actual sound level produced by the equipment, and you are still going to have existing activity or the existing ambient up to 68 decibels.

- Q. How do you reconcile that with your testimony where you make reference to no lower than 48 decibels?
- A. 48 is operational, not construction. So we are talking about preexisting construction, and then operational. So after construction is complete and the operation of the facility.
- Q. So 48 is what you are saying is post-construction?
- 21 A. Correct.

2.2

- Q. Operational of the plant?
- 23 A. Of the plant, yes.
- Q. And could you explain to me what the plus 5 decibel reference refers to?

A. Yes. The design goal as set by the noise study was the ambient -- it was the lowest ambient sound recording plus 5 decibels, which would be the design goal as the guidance we received from the Ohio Power Siting Board.

And as I understood it's not codified anywhere, but that has been the trend that they have been evaluating and presenting their noise studies and their -- what requires mitigation and/or, yes, anything to lower. So that is the guidance that we were directed towards.

- Q. And it's your understanding that was post-construction?
 - A. Correct.

- Q. So with respect to the construction itself you are not really opining on anything?
 - A. Correct.
- O. That sound level.
- A. That's correct.
 - Q. Did you share the results of any studies that you did with the Staff?
- A. Yes. They received -- the report is included in the Siting Board application. So they have this information in there.
