
Dear Madam or Sir:

I wanted to register my protest to being robbed by Public Utility Companies with the blessing of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

The basic facts:

- Your title begins with the word Public.
- The collective name of the industries you regulate begins with the word Public.
- Your November 2017 decision involving rules of Net Metering leads to the ability of the Public Utility that services me to rob me of a little more than they currently do.
- I pay the Public Utility for the line, the meter and the monitoring of the connection to my house.
- I pay for the electricity I use on a per kw basis.
- When I generate excess electricity they pay me on a per kw basis.
- I pay them more for the kw they provide than they pay me for the kw I provide.
- They keep track of the kw I provide and sell them at a premium to others in the system who demand kw generated from a renewable source.
- I save money from the kw I generate.
- They make money from the kw I generate.

Since the November 2017 decision allows me to save less money and the Public Utility to make more money, and that was done without my consent, I consider it equivalent to being robbed.
