{¶ 1} Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. (VEDO) is a natural gas company as defined in R.C. 4905.03 and a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 2} On May 1, 2018, VEDO filed an application requesting an adjustment to its Distribution Replacement Rider for the period September 1, 2018, through August 31, 2019.

{¶ 3} On May 7, 2018, the attorney examiner issued an Entry establishing a procedural schedule in this matter that included July 20, 2018, as the deadline for filing motions to intervene.

{¶ 4} On May 31, 2018, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed a motion to intervene. In its motion, OCC states that it represents the residential consumers of VEDO and that the interests of these customers may be adversely affected by the outcome of this case. OCC submits that it has a real and substantial interest in this proceeding and that its participation in this matter will not unduly prolong or delay the proceeding.

{¶ 5} No memoranda contra were filed in response to the motion to intervene filed by OCC.

{¶ 6} The attorney examiner finds that OCC's motion to intervene is reasonable and should be granted.

{¶ 7} It is, therefore,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That the motion to intervene filed by OCC be granted. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party and interested person of record.
