Ladies and Gentlemen,

West Virginia PCS Alliance, L.C., PUCOID 300180 Certificate Number 90-5447 ("NTELOS") was acquired by Shenandoah Telecommunications Company and subsequently consolidated into a wholly owned subsidiary of Shenandoah Telecommunications Company, Shenandoah Personal Communications, LLC (Shentel). Shentel has a longstanding contractual relationship with Sprint, whereby Shentel deploys and operates a wireless network used by Sprint customers.

Upon the closing of the merger, the majority of customers of NTELOS were assigned to Sprint, and Sprint began reporting revenues for such customers. However, certain business and education customers of NTELOS, as well as customers located in Parkersburg, West Virginia, were not immediately assigned to Sprint, and were transitioned to Sprint on a rolling basis. Customers located in Parkersburg, West Virginia (and surrounding areas) were assigned to Sprint as of April 2017. As of the third quarter of 2017, all remaining customers, including all business enterprise and educational customers, transitioned to the Sprint billing system.

As such, this letter is to advise the Commission that West Virginia PCS Alliance, LC is filing to have its Registration cancelled with the State of Ohio.
