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MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The Amendment to the 2018 Long Term Forecast Report of the American Electric Power Company (AEP) filed in this case on September 19, 2018 seeks a need determination for purposes of R.C. 4928.143(B)(2)(c) for 900 megawatts of renewable generation facilities in the State. The question presented is relatively novel, complex, and is likely to attract considerable public interest. Such facilities would potentially have very significant consequences, financial and environmental, for decades. Staff believes that these factors constitute good cause for purposes of requiring a hearing under R.C. 4935.04(D)(3).

Given that the outcome of this application would have very significant consequences and the question presented is one the Commission has rarely addressed, the Commission itself and all parties would benefit by a full development of the facts of the situation. This necessitates discovery and an opportunity for discussions. Accomplishing this development in a complete fashion within 90 days does not appear feasible.

Therefore the Staff requests that the Commission set a hearing within the ninety days required by R.C. 4928.143(D)(3) but call and continue that hearing to allow the time needed to fully develop the record in this complicated and relatively novel case.
