## REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

SUBMITTED ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

On September 11, 2018, Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. dba Legacy Inmate Communications (Legacy) and Jail Education Solutions, Inc. dba Edovo (Edova) filed an application notifying the Commission of a direct transfer of ownership of Legacy to Edovo. As a result of a stock purchase agreement executed between the parties, Edova has acquired 100% of the equity of Legacy. As a result, Legacy has become a wholly-owned subsidiary of Edova resulting in a change of ownership. After the changes, applicants state that Legacy will continue to offer the same services under the same name, rates, terms and conditions as currently offered. This application is being filed pursuant to Section 4901:1-6-29(C) as adopted in Case No. 14-1554-TP-ORD.

O.A.C. 4901:1-7-29(C) requires the filing of a CIO application for any change in ownership that is transparent to customers involving one or more telephone companies not providing BLES. Section 4901:1-6-29(C) O.A.C. allows for a zero day notice filing for a change in ownership that is transparent to customers for telephone companies not providing BLES.

The Staff has reviewed all documents filed with the application and has determined that the application has satisfied the requirements set forth in the rule. As such, Staff recommends that the application be approved with an effective date of September 11, 2018.
