

Tax practitioners and subchapter S shareholders need to be aware that Revenue Ruling 74-44 states that the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) will re-characterize small business corporation dividends paid to shareholders as salary when such dividends are paid to the shareholders in lieu of reasonable compensation for services.

The IRS may also re-characterize distributions other than dividend distributions as salary. This position has been supported in several recent court decisions.

The supplier bills the customer directly and if that customer pays their bill, the supplier pays TEB a commission. If there are any problems between the supplier and the customer, the customer is instructed to first contact TEB to facilitate a resolution. But the ultimate responsibility to solve any problem resides with the supplier. Since our inception, we have not had one problem that we were not able to resolve amicably and no customers to my knowledge have terminated their contract prematurely.

All of the requirements mandated in 4928.10 of the Revised Code are spelled out in the supplier contract, which is provided at the time of contracting.






