I. SUMMARY

(¶ 1) The Commission dismisses this case, as the Respondent has paid the civil forfeiture in full.

II. DISCUSSION

- {¶ 2} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Gary Crull (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-07, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- {¶ 3} On May 31, 2018, Respondent requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- {¶ 4} A prehearing conference was held on July 12, 2018. The parties, however, were unable to resolve this matter during the conference.
- {¶ 5} By Entry dated July 19, 2018, the attorney examiner scheduled a hearing for August 21, 2018.
- {¶6} On August 22, 2018, Staff filed a notice requesting to terminate further proceedings. In the notice, Staff explains that Respondent paid the full amount of the forfeiture requested, \$100.
- {¶ 7} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-22 provides, in pertinent part, that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all further proceedings regarding the violation.
 - $\{\P 8\}$ In view of the payment of the forfeiture, this case should be closed.
