{¶ 1} On June 29, 2018, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) filed an application to adjust its Rider Advanced Utility (Rider AU) to allow recovery of 2017 costs for the deployment of its grid modernization and related systems.

{¶ 2} By Entry issued July 3, 2018, the attorney examiner, among other things, set September 28, 2018, as the deadline for the filing of motions to intervene.

{¶ 3} On July 16, 2018, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed a motion to intervene. In its motion, OCC states that it represents Duke's residential consumers and that the interests of these customers may be adversely affected by the outcome of this case. OCC submits that it has a real and substantial interest in this proceeding and that its participation in this matter will not unduly prolong or delay the proceeding.

{¶ 4} No memoranda contra were filed in response to the motion to intervene filed by OCC.

{¶ 5} The attorney examiner finds that OCC's motion to intervene is reasonable and should be granted.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the motion to intervene filed by OCC be granted. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
