{¶ 1} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, Staff served a notice of preliminary determination (NPD) upon Steven J. Dodson (Respondent) alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On August 29, 2018, counsel for Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing regarding the NPD as contemplated by Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), the parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing conference on December 18, 2018, at 10:00 a.m.¹ At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Respondent's counsel, Mr. Michael J.
