19 MR. McNAMEE: On behalf of the Staff of
20 the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, I am Thomas

24 EXAMINER PRICE: Thank you.

1 MR. GRIFFIN: Yes, your Honor. Before we
2 do that I would like to stipulate into the evidence

5 EXAMINER PRICE: So marked.
