11 discussion with the parties and where they stood
12 with respect to such a filing, but we are not
13 making that filing at this time.

14 ATTORNEY EXAMINER PRICE: And I am
15 not approving it. Agreed?

16 MR. CAMPBELL: We would not oppose.

17 ATTORNEY EXAMINER PRICE: Not at
18 this time. Okay.

19 Well, then, we will then go forward
20 on January 7th, 2019 at 10:00 o'clock. There is
21 currently a hearing scheduled in 11-A so we will
22 be here in 11-C. If 11-A opens up we will go
23 ahead and move the hearing there. So, when you
