**I. SUMMARY**

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice, as the issues in the case have been resolved.

**II. DISCUSSION**

{¶ 2} Pursuant to R.C. 4927.21, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a telephone company by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the telephone company that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.

{¶ 3} The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Ohio (AT&T Ohio) is a telephone company as defined in R.C. 4905.03 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 4} On October 4, 2018, Eversole Builders, Inc. (Eversole) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio, alleging that AT&T Ohio quoted Eversole an excessive amount to complete a pedestal relocation.

{¶ 5} AT&T Ohio filed its answer on October 24, 2018. In its answer, AT&T Ohio admits some and denies other allegations of the complaint and sets forth several affirmative defenses.

{¶ 6} On December 17, 2018, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. The parties explain that they have settled this matter and executed a confidential settlement agreement.

{¶ 7} Being advised that the parties have settled the issues raised in the complaint, the Commission finds that the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.

### III. ORDER

{¶ 8} It is, therefore,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice be granted. It is, further,


{¶ 10} ORDERED, That this case be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

{¶ 11} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon the parties and all interested persons of record.




