## APPLICATION OF THE DAYTON POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF A REVISED BILL FORMAT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE

- 1. Applicant The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility and electric light company as defined by R.C. § 4905.02 and § 4905.03(A)(4) respectively, and an electric distribution utility as defined by R.C. § 4928.01(A)(6) and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the Commission).
- 2. DP&L requests the Commission's approval of a revised bill format for the Company's residential and nonresidential net metering customers to include "Received" and "Net" kWh in the Usage Detail portion of page 1 of the bill. DP&L hereby requests approval of the sample revised bill format attached as Exhibit 1.
- 3. DP&L's objective in designing this revised bill format is to more clearly present net metering customers' billing information in a manner that is user-friendly.
- 4. DP&L intends to implement the new bill format with Commission approval of the application in this matter.
- 5. The proposed bill format complies with O.A.C. 4901:1-10-22 and should be approved pursuant to O.A.C. Sections 4901:1-10-22(C) for the reasons stated above.

### **CONCLUSION**

DP&L respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Application pursuant to O.A.C. Section 4901:1-10-22(C) to revise DP&L's current billing format for both its residential and nonresidential net metering customers.
