1.	Q.	Please state your name and business address.
	A.	My name is John L. Berringer. My business address is 180 East Broad

2.	Q.	By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
	A.	I am employed by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO or
		Commission) as a Utility Specialist 2 in the Research and Policy Division
		of the Rates and Analysis Department. My duties include conducting
		investigations of assigned phases of rate case applications and other
		financial audits of public utility companies subject to the jurisdiction of the
		PUCO.
3.	Q.	Would you briefly state your educational background?
	A.	I earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree from The Ohio State University in
		1991. In 2012, I earned a post-baccalaureate Certificate of Accounting
		Concentration from Columbus State Community College.
4.	Q.	Please briefly outline your work experience.
	A.	I have been with the PUCO since July 2003 and in the Rates and Analysis
		Department since April 2009. Prior to working at the PUCO, I held various
		positions in the insurance, education, and healthcare industries.

1	5.	Q.	Have you testified in prior proceedings before the Commission?
2		A.	Yes.

4	6.	Q.	What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?
5		A.	The purpose of my testimony is to address Objection 3 and Objection 25
6			from the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC).

8	7.	Q.	OCC's Objection 3 states that "Staff failed to recommend (but should have
9			recommended) that a portion of investor relations expense be removed from
10			test year operating expenses". How do you respond?
11		A.	Staff agrees in principle with the objection. However, the issue regarding
12			investor relations expense was not included in the terms of the Stipulation
13			for this case. Staff believes that the Stipulation represents a fair and
14			reasonable compromise of issues raised among the signatory parties.
15			Therefore, Staff recommends that no modification to the Stipulation be
16			made with regard to this issue.

18	8.	Q.	OCC's Objection 25 states that the PUCO Staff Report failed to
19			recommend with regard to Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc.'s (VEDO
20			or Company) rate case expense that parties have the opportunity to object
21			to the Company's most recent updated information prior to the Commission
22			entering a Final Order. How do you respond?

1		А.	Staff acknowledges that it did not state in the Staff Report that the parties
2			have the opportunity to object to the Company's most recent updated rate
3			case expense information prior to the Commission entering a Final Order.
4			Staff agrees with the objection, and recommends that the Commission
5			allow the parties to have the opportunity to object to the Company's most
6			recent updated rate case expense information prior to the Commission
7			entering a Final Order.
