**{¶ 1}** Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, Staff served a notice of preliminary determination (NPD) upon Thrifty Propane, Inc. (Respondent) alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.

**{¶ 2}** On August 20, 2018, counsel for Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing regarding the NPD as contemplated by Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13. After a prehearing conference did not result in settlement of the matter, the attorney examiner set a hearing date of January 24, 2019.

**{¶ 3}** On January 23, 2019, Respondent filed a motion to continue. Respondent represents that a continuance will allow the parties to more fully explore the potential for resolving the matter without need of a hearing. The motion also states that Respondent discussed the proposed continuance with Staff, who indicated no objection to the request.

**{¶ 4}** The attorney examiner finds that the motion for a continuance is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the hearing is continued to April 23, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., in Hearing Room 11-D at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

**{¶ 6}** ORDERED, That Respondent's motion for a continuance be granted and the hearing be continued to April 23, 2019, as stated in Paragraph 4. It is, further,
