{¶ 1} Ohio Power Company d/b/a AEP Ohio (AEP Ohio) is an electric distribution utility, as defined in R.C. 4928.01(A)(6), and a public utility, as defined in R.C. 4905.02, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 2} On April 16, 2018, as amended and supplemented on May 31, 2018, June 26, 2018, and September 19, 2018, AEP Ohio filed its long-term forecast report (LTFR) for 2018 in Case No. 18-501-EL-FOR (*LTFR Case*).

{¶ 3} By Entry dated October 22, 2018, the *LTFR Case* was consolidated with Case No. 18-1392-EL-RDR and Case No. 18-1393-EL-ATA and the proceedings were bifurcated into two phases.

{¶ 4} The evidentiary hearing for the first phase of these proceedings was called, as scheduled, on December 4, 2018, continued to January 15, 2019, and concluded on February 8, 2019. At the conclusion of the hearing, the parties agreed to file initial briefs by March 6, 2019, and to file reply briefs by March 27, 2019.

{¶ 5} It was brought to the attorney examiner's attention that volumes six and seven of the hearing transcripts (January 23, 2019, and January 24, 2019) are paginated incorrectly. Corrected volumes six and seven will be filed in the case dockets as of the date of this Entry. All parties are directed to cite to the corrected volumes six and seven transcripts in their briefs.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That all briefs cite to the corrected volumes six and seven transcripts. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and other interested persons of record.
