On January 30, 2019, FiberLight, LLC. (FiberLight) filed an application seeking authority to provide telecommunications services throughout Ohio on a facilities-based and resale basis. Specifically, FiberLight intends to provide special access and private line services primarily to wholesale carriers and enterprise business customers. FiberLight will build its own facilities including fiber and obtain inputs, such as dark fiber, from other carriers to provide service to its customers. FiberLight does no intend to offer telecommunications service to residential customers.

The Application is being filed pursuant to the Commission's 14-1554-TP-ORD Retail Rules, as codified in 4901:1-6-08 of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). Absent full or partial suspension, certification applications will be approved in accordance with the thirty-day automatic approval process described in rule 4901:1-6-05 of the O.A.C. The Staff has reviewed all documents and exhibits filed with this application. The Applicant has demonstrated that it has the requisite technical, financial and managerial expertise to provide service in Ohio.

Staff has determined that the proposed application satisfies the Commission's requirements set forth in 4901:1-6-08 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Staff therefore recommends that this application be automatically approved on March 1, 2019.
