8		In 1997, I graduated from Clarion University with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History
9		and Political Science and subsequently received a Master's Degree in Political Science
10		from Ohio University. From 1998-2008 I worked for various non-profit public policy
11		advocacy organizations including Environmental Ohio, where I was the Executive
12		Director from 2003-2008.

15		I am employed by EDP Renewables North America LLC ("EDP Renewables"), which is
16		the parent company for Paulding Wind Farm IV, LLC ("Applicant"). My initial role
17		with EDP Renewables was as a Project Manager responsible for advancing the
18		development of wind farm projects in Ohio and throughout the Eastern Region of EDP
19		Renewables.

25	•	As the Director of Project Management, I oversee wind and solar renewable energy
26		projects from late stage development efforts through construction and into operations.
27		Since 2008, I have overseen the development and construction of five wind farm projects
28		totaling 682 megawatts ("MWs") currently in operations in Ohio, Indiana, and New

York. I was involved in all aspects of the previous Paulding Wind Farm wind-power

generation facilities certificated by the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") and built in

Ohio by EDP Renewables (Case Nos. 09-980-EL-BGN and 10-369-EL-BGN) and have

been involved in all aspects of the Applicant's wind farm ("Timber Road IV Wind Farm") that was recently certified by the Board (Case No. 18-91-EL-BGN). I have also been involved in all aspects of the Applicant's Transmission Line Project ("Project") that is proposed by the Applicant in this case. From land acquisition to environmental studies to engineering and construction planning, I am familiar with all aspects of the Project development.

7. Please state the purpose of your testimony.

The purpose of my testimony is to provide a summary of the Project and a description of the process that led to the joint stipulation and recommendation ("Stipulation"), which was filed in the docket on March 8, 2019, and is being offered in this proceeding as Joint Exhibit 1. I will sponsor the admission of the Stipulation into evidence in this case, along with the Applicant's exhibits listed in the Stipulation, which include the Application and supplement, certificates of service, and proofs of publication. I intend to explain the background of the Stipulation and the reasons why I believe it should be adopted by the Board. In addition, my testimony will confirm that the Stipulation complies with the Board's three-part test for evaluating stipulations.

8. Please provide a summary and description of the Project.

As described in detail in the Application, which was filed in this case on October 17, 2018, as supplemented and clarified on February 1, and 5, 2019 ("Application"), the Project consists of a 2.9-mile 138 kilovolt transmission line and associated laydown yard in Paulding County, Ohio. The Project is associated with the Timber Road IV Wind Farm in Paulding County. The primary purpose of the Project is to deliver up to 75.9 MW of clean, renewable electricity generated by the Timber Road IV Wind Farm from the wind farm's collection substation to the existing Logtown substation, point of interconnection, via the existing Timber Road III Transmission Line.

The preferred route for the Project was selected because it was determined to be the most efficient way to deliver electricity generated by the Timber Road IV Wind Farm to the regional power grid. In addition, the preferred route also had less environmental and

social impacts, and will be less costly. Thus, after taking all factors into consideration, following discussions with local officials and taking into consideration landowner preferences, the Applicant determined that the location of the preferred route for the Project is ideal.

9. Please provide the background concerning the discussions leading up to the Stipulation.

The Board's Staff ("Staff") issued a Staff Report of Investigation on February 15, 2019 ("Staff Report"). A local public hearing was subsequently held at the Ohio State University Extension Building in Paulding, Ohio on March 5, 2019. The Stipulation, which was signed by the Applicant, Staff, and the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation ("OFBF"), was filed on March 8, 2019. The evidentiary hearing is scheduled to commence March 19, 2019, at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

In my opinion, Staff completed its investigation process seamlessly. The Applicant did not detect any major issues or hurdles during Staff's investigation of the Application. We do not have concerns with the Staff Report and our proposed Stipulation revisions related to minor refinement of condition language. Note that the OFBF is the only intervenor in this case and has been involved in the development of and discussions regarding the Stipulation.

10. Did you encounter any objections to the Project from the officials in the area?

No. The Applicant has been working in Paulding County and meeting with landowners regarding the Paulding Wind Farm facilities for over ten years. Throughout this time, we have formed strong relationships with local landowners, as well as county officials.

11. Why do you believe the Stipulation should be adopted by the Board?

In my opinion, the Stipulation is a reasonable, good faith settlement that resulted from thoughtful negotiations among capable, knowledgeable parties to the case. Not only does the Stipulation address all questions that have been expressed by the parties, but, in addition, the stipulated conditions ensure that the Project will serve the public interest.

The Applicant estimates that construction and operation of the Project, as well as the Timber Road IV Wind Farm, will increase employment in the area. Moreover, we expect the Project to have a significant positive impact on the local tax base, including local school districts and other taxing districts that serve the Project area. Assuming an estimated nameplate capacity of 75.9 MWs, the increase in local tax revenues could be as much as \$683,100 annually for the facility.

Finally, as a package, the Stipulation benefits ratepayers and the public interest, providing enormous economic benefits to the surrounding local community. In so doing, the Stipulation package does not violate any regulatory principle or practice. As such, we

believe the Stipulation should be adopted by the Board.

Yes. The Applicant is appreciative of the efforts the Staff has made in processing this Application and culminating in the issuance of the February 15, 2019 Staff Report. In addition, the Applicant would like to thank the OFBF for its participation in the case, as well as local community leaders in Paulding County, and the community itself for all of their participation in this process.
