I urge you to reject any applications for wind farm installations in rural Seneca County. Such installations would ruin the rural nature of the area and severely limit any future growth in local cities and towns. My wife and I purchased property and an old farmhouse in eastern Seneca County several years ago. Our intent was to have a vacation home near my wife's family farms. Since then we have come to enjoy the peaceful, rural nature of the area and we have made a significant investment in our property. It has become our primary residence. However, we cannot see a way where we could live among industrial wind turbines and, like so many of our neighbors, we feel we would need to leave the area if these installations proceed. Secondly, we see and are encouraged by the investment the residents of Tiffin OH are making in their city. The people of Tiffin have a great deal of civic spirit and constant improvements are being made throughout town. I cannot see how this investment can continue if the surrounding area is destroyed with the installation of wind turbines. Rural Ohio, like so many other areas in the United States, is in a position to take advantage of the economic boom our country is experiencing. You cannot drive through the area without seeing a help wanted sign outside of nearly every business, both large and small. In order to attract people to fill these positions we must offer them a pleasant place to live. Such a place is not among 600+ foot wind turbines.
