ENTRY

Entered in the Journal on April 2, 2019

{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4906.04, no person shall construct a major utility facility without first having obtained a certificate from the Ohio Power Siting Board (Board). In seeking a certificate, applicants must comply with the filing requirements outlined in R.C. 4906.04, as well as Ohio Adm.Code Chapters 4906-2 and 4906-5.

{¶ 2} On August 20, 2018, the Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L or Company) filed a motion with the Board indicating that it is preparing a filing before the Board for approval of a new 17-mile, 138 kilovolt transmission line from the existing West Milton Substation to the existing Eldean Substation located northwest of Troy, Ohio. For purposes of expediting the filing, DP&L requested three waivers.

{¶ 3} On September 4, 2018, Staff responded to DP&L's motion requesting waivers.

{¶ 4} By Entry dated September 20, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) granted DP&L's motion in part and denied it in part.

{¶ 5} On February 1, 2019, DP&L filed its application with the Commission.

{¶ 6} On April 1, 2019, DP&L filed a letter with the Commission, requesting a 60-day suspension of the compliance review schedule in this matter. In the letter, DP&L explains that the requested temporary suspension will enable the Company to submit an addendum to the original application for Staff review.

{¶ 7} On the same day, Staff filed a letter, indicating that it does not oppose DP&L's request.

{¶ 8} Upon review, the ALJ finds that DP&L's request is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, the compliance review schedule is suspended for 60 days from the date of this Entry.

{¶ 9} It is, therefore,

{¶ 10} ORDERED, That the compliance review schedule in this matter be suspended for 60 days from the date of this Entry. It is, further,

{¶ 11} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
