Additionally, conditions 31 and 32 are 19 20 recommended by Staff, to ensure the Applicant coordinates with local

5	9.	Q.	In condition 32, what is a financial assurance?
6			Financial assurance is a financial instrument in the form of a letter of credit,
7			cash or surety bond that sets aside money available to a government entity
8			for the necessary repairs to the roads and bridges.

10	10.	Q.	In condition 31, what is included in a Transportation Management Plan
11			(TMP)?
12			A TMP lays out a set of strategies for managing the work zone impacts of a
13			project. It is ultimately up to the Applicant and the individual agencies to
14			establish and implement TMPs that best serve the mobility and safety needs
15			of the motoring public, construction workers, businesses, and community.

17	11.	Q.	Does this conclude your testimony?
