TO WHAT EXTENT CAN LOCAL OFFICIALS OR CITIZENS BE OF ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING INCIDENTS?

Once the reporting rule is drafted and approved. Township Trustees, County Commissioners and Local Law enforcement shall be made aware of the incidents requiring reporting and they should be given emergency (off hours) reporting numbers to the oversight authority for incident reporting.

All registered voters within the townships that have a turbine sited shall be made aware of the incidents to be reported and be given contact numbers for the PUC and/or the OPSB to allow a defense in depth approach to ensuring turbine incidences are identified since this population comprises "eyes on the ground".
