**Background**

On April 24, 2019, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., (Company) filed an application to update its Retail Capacity (RC) and Retail Energy (RE) riders. The proposed tariffs include Standard Service Offer (SSO) generation rates, and Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) generation rates.

The proposed SSO rates include the results of the most recent auction held February 26, 2019, approved by the Commission on February 27, 2019 in Case No. 18-6000-EL-UNC. The proposed PIPP generation rates reflect the results of the PIPP auction held March 11, 2019, and approved by the Commission on March 13, 2019 in Case No. 16-940-EL-UNC.

The Company requests that the proposed tariffs become effective on June 1, 2019.

**Staff Review and Recommendations**

Staff has reviewed the proposed tariffs filed on April 24, 2019, and finds that the tariffs appear to be in compliance with Commission Orders and accurately reflect the February 26, 2019, and March 11, 2019, auction results.

**Conclusion**

The Staff recommends that the proposed tariffs filed April 24, 2019, be approved and become effective June 1, 2019.
