

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILIT

American Transmission Systems, incorporated ("ATSI") a FirstEnergy company, proposes to Expand the Existing Brim Substation, ("Project"), in a Letter of Notification Application submitted to the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need.

The Project is located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Brim Road and Bishop Road in Plain Township, Wood County Ohio. The substation expansion will be located entirely within the existing Toledo Edison owned property. ATSI proposes to expand and improve the existing substation to provide enhancements to efficiency, reliability, and operational fluxibility of these systems.
