Effective August 1, 2019, local telephone rates for business and residential customers in the Conneaut, Kingsville and Pierpont exchanges will increase by \$1.25 per month as listed in the table below. Many rural telephone companies, including Conneaut Telephone Company, receive support from the Federal Universal Service Fund. New rules reduce such support if a telephone company's local rates are below the national average. The \$1.25 increase is necessary to bring our local rates more in line with the national average and to avoid reduction in our Federal Universal Service Fund support.
