What if Duke's proposed pipeline exploded in the section of the 'alternate' route in a residential neighborhood in Reading where hundreds of people live?

High capacity natural gas pipelines DO NOT belong in densely populated urban/suburban areas! Please DO NOT approve Duke's unsafe, unnecessary pipeline.
