{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Energy Transportation, LLC (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On July 29, 2019, Pasco Altovilla, in his capacity as Compliance Director for Respondent, requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing conference on September 9, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Respondent by telephone.
