WE HAVE LIVED HERE FOR OVER 57 YEARS AND ARE VERY CONCERNED ABOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF A WIND TURBINE BEING PUT LESS THAN 1/2 MILE FROM MY HOME. I HAVE SOME HEALTH ISSUES; A D-FIBULATOR PLUS 2 PACE MAKERS AND AM WORRIED HOW THE TURBINE MIGHT INTERFERE WITH THEM. PLEASE DO WHAT'S RIGHT AND IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE RURAL COMMUNITY, OUR SAFETY AND OUR HEALTH. DO NOT GRANT A PERMIT TO APEX FOR THE PROPOSED REPUBLIC WIND PROJECT.
