I. SUMMARY

 $\{\P 1\}$ The Commission corrects details in a prior Finding and Order concerning the sources of funds for surface reconstruction at a grade crossing in the city of Mt. Vernon.

II. DISCUSSION

- {¶ 2} On July 31, 2019, the Commission issued a Finding and Order approving an upgrade to gates and lights, reconstruction of the crossing surface, and installation of traffic preemption at the Parrot Street grade crossing (DOT#152068H) in the city of Mt. Vernon, Knox County. The Commission ordered completion of the project by April 30, 2020.
- {¶ 3} Paragraph 6 of the July 31, 2019 Finding and Order states that 10 percent of the surface reconstruction funds, specifically \$14,349.60, would be provided by the Columbus & Ohio River Railroad (CUOH).
- {¶ 4} Staff filed a memorandum on August 26, 2019, stating that it had erred in the project application by stating that CUOH will provide part of the funding for surface reconstruction at the project. Staff emphasizes that, instead, 10 percent of surface reconstruction costs, \$14,349.60, will be provided by the city of Mt. Vernon, which is the local highway authority. Staff requests that the Commission amend the Finding and Order to specify the proper funding distribution.

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{¶ 5} Accordingly, Paragraph 6 of the July 31, 2019 Finding and Order should be amended to indicate that 10 percent of the surface reconstruction funds, \$14,349.60, will be provided by the city of Mt. Vernon. In all other respects, the July 31, 2019 Finding and Order shall remain unchanged.

III. ORDER

- {¶ 7} ORDERED, That the July 31, 2019 Finding and Order be corrected nunc pro tunc in accordance with Paragraph 5. It is, further,
- {¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon ORDC, CUOH, Mayor of the city of Mt. Vernon, AEP, and any other interested person of record.
