ALJ AGRANOFF: Why don't we go on the record.

The Ohio Power Siting Board has assigned for hearing at this time and place Case No.

17-2295-EL-BGN which is captioned in the Matter of the Application of Republic Wind, LLC, for a

Certificate to Site Wind-Powered Electric Generation Facilities in Seneca and Sandusky Counties, Ohio.

My name is Jay Agranoff and seated with me is Anna Sanyal and we are the Administrative Law Judges assigned by the Board to hear this particular case.

Pursuant to the entry of August 19, 2019, we were originally scheduled to have the beginning of the adjudicatory hearing to begin today, but pursuant to the entry of September 12, 2019, we are now having a call and continue of the adjudicatory hearing.

So basically what we are going to do now is just take the appearances and go through the procedural schedule that was laid out in that September 12 entry and then we will conclude and then you will be able to have your discussions as you see

appropriate.

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So at this point in time why don't we go ahead and take the appearances on behalf of the Applicant.

And I would also note that there are a couple local residents who are Intervenors in this particular case who, I believe, Mr. Van Kley, you are not representing; is that correct?

MR. VAN KLEY: Correct, your Honor.

ALJ AGRANOFF: And are there any members of the public or the residential landowners who are not represented by Mr. Van Kley present at this time?

Okay. Let the record reflect that they are not in attendance.

Basically as I had indicated previously, we laid out a procedural schedule in the entry of September 12, and I will just reiterate for the record so that everybody is clear. We have the expert and factual testimony to be offered by Republic that will be filed by October 21, 2019. Then all expert and factual testimony to be offered by Intervenors and Staff shall be filed by October 28, 2019. We will then have a telephonic prehearing conference that will take place on October 23 at 10 o'clock. And when we go off the record, I will provide you with the call in information so that you will have that at your disposal.

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And it is our expectation that hopefully counsel will be able to work with one another for the purposes of scheduling witnesses for the purposes of having the adjudicatory hearing in this matter and that when we reconvene on the 23rd telephonically, that you will be able to report a proposed schedule of witnesses that we hopefully will be able to utilize for the purposes of going forward.

Are there any questions at this time?

And I would also point out that to the extent that there is any stipulations that result through any settlement negotiations, that that

stipulation would need to be filed by October 28, 2019, as well.

And along those lines obviously to the extent that there is either a full or partial stipulation, there may be an impact on the calendar that we've been discussing at this point in time because obviously then we may now be using the stip as the target for the purposes of any adjudicatory hearing and that may impact our hearing calendar so that would be part of those conversations that we would have when we have our telephonic status conference.
