Jay Ferry – I have been assigned to review the A and B exhibits of this application here at the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. Someone else may contact you with questions or comments about your C exhibits. During review I have noted some issues that need to be addressed in order to bring this application into compliance with Ohio laws.

- 1. A-8 on the application form was not completed.
- 2. The affidavit was not attached. The affidavit is the last two pages in the pdf of the application form available from the Commission's website.
- 3. The application was filed outside of the renewal window stated in Ohio Administrative Code 4901:1-24-09. In accordance with rule 09, "Any renewal application filed fewer than thirty calendar days prior to the expiration date indicated on the certificate, but no later than the expiration date on the certificate, shall be filed with a motion requesting an extension of the certificate." The motion requesting an extension must be filed in conformance with Ohio Administrative Code 4901:1-24-07 which states, in part, that the motion, "must be filed by an attorney authorized to practice law in the state of Ohio."

Please correct these items and file the updated information along with a cover letter stating that you are making a revision in <u>Case No. 17-2113-EL-AGG</u> by <u>Friday, November 8, 2019</u>. You do not need to submit the entire application again, only those sections that are being revised. Again, keep in mind that you may receive a separate request for information from the staff member reviewing your financial exhibits and that person may give you a different deadline for those requirements. I am the PUCO Staff member assigned to review the C-Exhibits associated with your renewal application docketed under Case Number 17-2113-EL-AGG. This application was filed recently.

Upon review, it has been determined that the response to Exhibit C-5 is not in the prescribed format. To clarify, and relying upon the applicable filing instructions:

• For Case Number 17-2113-EL-AGG, provide two years of forecasted income statements for the applicant's **ELECTRIC** related business activities in the state of Ohio Only, along with a list of assumptions, and the name, address, email address, and telephone number of the preparer. The forecasts should be in an annualized format for the two years succeeding the Application year.

Your projection for 2018 is not a forecast; it is history. Further, your Exhibit C-5, in regards to 2019, is not in the prescribed format as there are no financial statement line items in your submission. I have attached an example from the prior application to guide you.

In order to avoid suspension and/or denial of your application, please send the above referenced Exhibits to the PUCO Docketing Division with a note to include them as amendments to your applications for Case 17-2113-EL-AGG. Use separate sheets of paper for each of the required
