Notice of Proposed Major Utility Facility

Long Ridge Energy Generation LLC (Applicant) is proposing to construct a natural gas pipeline in Monroe County. The Applicant is planning to construct an approximately 9,963 foot, 12-inch natural gas transmission pipeline to deliver gas from an existing natural gas gathering system in Ohio Township, Monroe County, OH to a natural gas-fired electric generation plant being constructed by Applicant and located on State Route 7 north of Hannibal, OH.

The location of the proposed pipeline is shown on the map below:



A Letter of Notification has been filed and is now pending with the Ohio Power Siting Board (Board) under Case No. 19-1742-GA-BLN in order to construct, operate and maintain the proposed pipeline described above.
