#### THE DAYTON POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY'S NOTICE OF FILING PROPOSED TARIFFS

The Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L") provides notice of filing proposed tariffs. The tariffs are consistent with the tariffs that the Commission approved in its August 26, 2016 Opinion and Order in this matter ("ESP I") and that were in effect before the Commission's October 10, 2017 Opinion & Order in Case. No. 16-395-EL-SSO ("ESP III"). The attached tariffs should remain in effect until a subsequent Standard Service Offer is approved pursuant to section R.C. 4928.143 or section 4928.142 of the Revised Code.

The following riders and tariffs from DP&L's most recent standard service offer will be implemented as they existed in 2017 before the Commission's decision in ESP III:

> 1. Infrastructure Investment Rider (D29)

2. Rate Stabilization Charge (Previously G25, now 612)

To address the fact that competitive bidding has occurred, DP&L will honor existing contracts with winning competitive bid suppliers through the end of their term (May 2021) and maintain current PJM obligations for all suppliers. This will maintain the integrity of the competitive bid process and allow non-shopping customers to continue to benefit from market-based rates. To achieve this, Tariffs for Standard Offer Generation (previously G10-G18, G27-G28) and Transmission Cost Recovery-Bypassable (previously T9) in effect prior to the Commission's decision in ESP III will be re-instated, but will be combined into a single Tariff (G10) and reflect the Standard Offer Rate that is in existence today.

The following tariffs will not be changed from how they exist currently:

- 1. Distribution Tariffs (D1- D28, D30-D39, D41)<sup>1</sup>
- 2. Transmission Tariffs (T1-T8)
- 3. Generation Tariffs (G1-G11)

The following riders and tariffs that exist currently will be eliminated:

- 1. Smart Grid Rider (D29)
- 2. Reconciliation Rider (D40)
