I. SUMMARY

 $\{\P 1\}$ The Commission grants the parties' joint motion to dismiss this complaint case, on grounds that the parties have reached a settlement resolving all issues raised.

II. DISCUSSION

- {¶ 2} Pursuant to R.C. 4927.21, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a telephone company by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the telephone company that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.
- {¶ 3} Respondent, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC (Cincinnati Bell), is a telephone company as defined in R.C. 4905.03 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- {¶ 4} On October 23, 2019, Vintage Uncorked, Inc. d/b/a A Bottle or Two filed a complaint against Cincinnati Bell, alleging that, at that time, a dispute pertaining to service termination issues existed between the parties.

{¶ 5} On November 7, 2019, the parties jointly filed a motion to dismiss this case, on grounds that the alleged dispute has been settled between the parties and that both parties now consider the matter resolved.
