Docketing Division:

On November 26, 2019 the company filed Sheet No. 110.31 (Rider AER-R Alternative Energy Recovery Rider) for purposes of setting an electric tariff in the above referenced cases for bills rendered beginning with the first billing cycle in January 2020. The filing did not incorporate any changes in methodology necessary to comply with HB 6.

Enclosed is a revised proposed tariff for purposes of setting the Company's electric tariff in the above referenced cases to become effective for bills rendered beginning with the first billing cycle in January 2020. The revised proposed tariff incorporated the following changes to comply with HB 6: (1) revised the benchmark for renewable sales from 6.5% to 5.5% of non-switched sales for compliance year 2020, (2) adjusted the 2020 renewable benchmark to remove annualized sales for self-assessing purchasers, (3) removed solar requirements, and (4) calculated a combined weighted average cost of inventory (WACI) rate which included both solar and non-solar inventories.

ALTERNATIVE ENERGY RECOVERY RIDER

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all retail jurisdictional customers in the Company's electric service territory who receive electric generation service from the Company under the Standard Service Offer. Rider AER-R does not apply to customers taking generation service from a Competitive Retail Electric Service provider. Rider AER-R does not apply to customers that are registered as self-assessing purchasers under R.C. 5727.81(C).

DESCRIPTION

This rider enables the recovery of all the Company's cost for complying with Ohio's renewable energy requirements under Section 4928.64 of Ohio Revised Code, including the acquisition costs of renewable energy credits. Rider AER-R will be adjusted quarterly and is subject to annual audit by the Commission.

This Rider is subject to reconciliation, including, but not limited to, refunds or additional charges to customers, as ordered by the Commission as the result of audits by the Commission in accordance with the December 19, 2018, Opinion and Order in Case Nos. 17-1263-EL-SSO, *et al.*

CHARGES

A charge of \$0.000212 per kWh shall be applied to all kWh delivered to all applicable customers.
