NOTICE OF APPARENT VIOLATION AND  
INTENT TO ASSESS FORFEITURE.

ENTRY

Submitted via Certified USPS Mail after receiving notice for a Commission Hearing

(¶ 1) On September 9, 2019, Jenny Triplett (Ms. Triplett or Respondent) requested an administrative hearing in accordance Ohio Admin. Code 4901:2-7-13 after not being notified of rights to a hearing from a previous conversation with Cheryl Streets in March of 2019.

(¶ 2) In an October 3, 2019 entry, a settlement teleconference was scheduled for October 31, 2019. Ms. Triplett was not present when staff attempted to contact her by telephone on October 31, 2019, due to her travel schedule. Staff let a message indicating how Respondent could return the call. Attorney Examiner, James Lynn, states a mistruth that the call was not returned, but Ms. Triplett has proof that it was and a message was left for Jim Lynn at 614.466.0102.


(¶ 3) At that time, the right to an application for re-hearing according to Ohio Admin Code 4901.1.35 was never presented to Ms. Triplett.

(¶ 4) The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has a pattern of behavior of trying to deny Respondent her rights from the time this citation was filed. Ms. Triplett was never notified of any requested hearing in March 2019 but subsequently severs with a collection notice in September 2019.

(¶ 5) Respondent asks that the Commission hearing scheduled for December 13, 2019 be removed from the docket.

(¶ 5) Based on the code stated in SECTION 3 and the neglect of the Commission to inform Ms. Triplett of her hearing rights, Respondent requests a rehearing and furthermore, due to a pattern of behavior to circumvent due process, Ms. Triplett is requesting that the citation be dismissed.

(¶ 6) ORDERED, that a copy of this ENTRY be served upon all parties of record.
