Re: PUCO Case No. 19-653-RR-FED- In the Matter of a Request for the Installation of Active Warning Devices at the CSX Transportation Inc. Grade Crossing, DOT#513-731Y, on Vanzandt Rd/TR 37 in Hancock County, Ohio.

On October 9, 2018, the Ohio Rail Development Commission (ORDC) authorized funding for CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSX) to install lights and gates at Vanzandt Road/TR 37, DOT#513-731Y in Hancock County, Ohio. The crossing was surveyed, on May 18, 2018, and was found to warrant the upgrade.

On April 17, 2019, the Commission approved the project and ordered completion by January 17, 2020.

On December 19, 2019, CSX filed for an extension until April 17, 2020 (see attached). In the request, CSX states that the team scheduled to complete this project is working in Marion, Ohio to complete a corridor project. They will take a 3-week break for the holidays and for Safety Certification in January. It is anticipated that it will be mid-February until the Marion project is complete and they can begin the Vanzandt Road project.

Staff notes that CSX has no firm deadline to complete the Marion corridor project. Staff believes that CSX has failed to show that good cause exists to grant additional time for completion of the project. Staff does not recommend a project extension.
