{¶ 1} On September 24, 2019, Staff served a notice of apparent violation and intent to assess forfeiture upon Caleb Salyers (Respondent), alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On December 13, 2019, the Commission received an email from Respondent wherein Respondent requested that his case be reopened. The attorney examiner, at this time, recognizes Respondent's correspondence as a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} The attorney examiner schedules this matter for a prehearing conference on January 28, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Respondent by telephone.
