{¶ 1} On September 9, 2019, Jenny Triplett (Respondent) requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-18.

{¶ 2} Respondent could not be contacted when Staff called her on October 31, 2019, for a prehearing conference.

{¶ 3} On November 5, 2019, an Entry was issued scheduling a December 13, 2019 hearing. A subsequent December 5, 2019 Entry rescheduled the hearing to January 23, 2020.

{¶ 4} On December 17, 2019, Respondent filed additional comments and information concerning her hearing request.

{¶ 5} On December 24, 2019, Staff filed a motion to dismiss the case.

{¶ 6} The attorney examiner finds that the January 23, 2020 hearing shall be continued to a date not yet determined, in order to better consider Respondent's additional comments and information, as well as the factors cited by Staff in its motion to dismiss.
