This is in response to your correspondence, received on January 7, 2020, regarding the Dayton Power & Light Bath-Trebein 138 kV reconductor project in Greene County, Ohio. The comments of the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) are made in accordance with the provisions of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and the associated regulations at 36 CFR Part 800.

The undertaking involves the replacement of approximately 4.6 miles of overhead electrical transmission lines. The Phase I survey confirmed that there are no historic properties within the project area. Therefore, SHPO agrees that this undertaking will not affect historic properties. No further coordination is required unless the scope of work changes or archaeological remains are discovered during the course of the project.
