- {¶ 2} On October 18, 2019, Hristina V. Barganska, Esq., on behalf of Respondent, requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- {¶ 3} On October 31, 2019, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference for November 25, 2019. During the prehearing conference, Staff and counsel for Respondent were unable to reach a settlement.
- $\{\P 4\}$ On December 12, 2019, the attorney examiner issued an Entry scheduling a hearing for January 30, 2020, at the Commission offices.
- {¶ 5} On January 29, 2020, parties filed a joint motion for a continuance and a request for expedited consideration requesting that the hearing be continued to a date to be determined later. For cause, the parties represent that a continuance will allow them more time to engage in negotiations to fully resolve this case by agreement. The parties further request that the Commission grant the motion expeditiously and without delay, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-12(C).
- $\{\P 6\}$ Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds the joint motion for a continuance and request for expedited consideration reasonable, is supported by good cause, and should be granted. The January 30, 2020 hearing shall be continued indefinitely.
