The Indiana & Ohio Railway Company (IORY) is submitting the following update for the above referenced project as a follow up to the traffic preemption issues.

The Ohio Rail Development Commission (ORDC)'s reviewed the timings and confirm that they match the recommendations supplied by ORDC. The railroad proceeded to contact its contractor to implement the changes.

On Tuesday, January 28th, IORY contractor Progress Rail completed the approved changes in the field. Service train passed over the crossings three (3) times, and the preemption worked as planned. Mott MacDonald, ORDC's Consultant, and the City of Mason were present for the testing.

There was noted a minor crossing activation issue after the crossing has recovered and train is leaving approach (tail ring). The logs were downloaded and are being analyzed for a solution. Once Progress Rail has analyzed the data, additional modifications will probably be necessary. All findings will be provided to the ORDC.
