- Q. And based on your knowledge and experience was this agreement entered into by capable and knowledgeable parties?
 - A. Yes, sir, it was.
- Q. Sir, are there benefits to the public interest or to consumers in entering into this agreement?
- A. Yes, there are benefits. Staff conducts these audits to verify that the costs that the utility incurs to provide natural gas service to the customers is accurate. And also to verify that those costs are accurately included in customer's rates.
- During the course of this audit

 Staff noticed some differences as they relate to
 the UEX, PIP and the GCR, and Staff made
 adjustments based on those differences. And

- those adjustments are highlighted in the
 stipulation.
- Q. There are also recommendations as to business practices and so forth for future proceedings?
- A. Yes, sir.

- Q. So in your opinion these
 resolutions, these recommendations, not only
 resolve the issues in this matter, but
 presumably pave the way for cleaner audits in
 the future?
 - A. Yes, sir. I believe so.
- Q. In your opinion, sir, does this
 agreement violate any regulatory practices or
 principles?
- A. No, sir, not that I am aware of.
- Q. And is it your recommendation that
 the Commission accept this Stipulation and
 Recommendation without modification?
