Dear Docket Submission Ohio Public Siting Board,

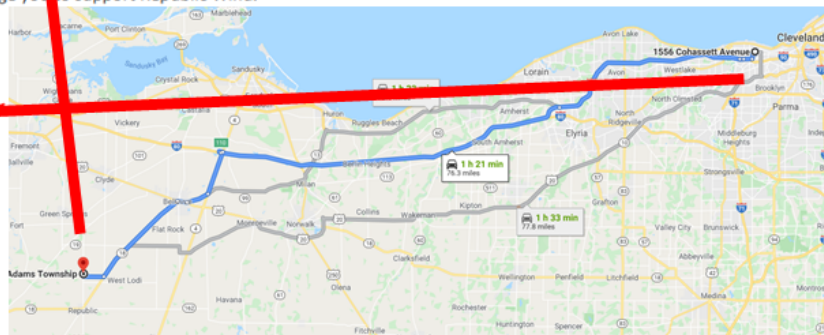
