I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the application for rehearing filed by the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel for the purpose of further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On April 17, 2019, the Commission opened the above-captioned case for Staff of the Commission's Service Monitoring and Enforcement Department (Staff) to investigate PALMco Energy OH, LLC d/b/a Indra Energy's and PALMco Power OH, LLC d/b/a Indra Energy's (collectively, PALMco) alleged misleading and deceptive practices to market and enroll customers, as well as violating several requirements of Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-21 and 4901:1-29.

{¶ 3} On January 29, 2020, the Commission issued an Opinion and Order, approving a Stipulation between PALMco and Staff.

{¶ 4} R.C. 4903.10 states that any party who has entered an appearance in a Commission proceeding may apply for rehearing with respect to any matters determined in that proceeding, by filing an application within 30 days after the entry of the order upon the journal of the Commission.

{¶ 5} On February 28, 2020, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed an application for rehearing.

{¶ 6} Finally, on March 9, 2020, PALMco filed a memorandum contra OCC's application for rehearing.

{¶ 7} Upon review, the Commission believes that OCC has set forth sufficient reasons to warrant further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing. Accordingly, OCC's February 28, 2020 application for rehearing should be granted.

III. ORDER

{¶ 8} It is, therefore,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That OCC's February 28, 2020 application for rehearing be granted for further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing. It is, further,
