On April 27, 2020, the Philip Schultz Residence submitted an application for certification of a generation facility as an eligible renewable energy resource generating facility. Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(D), an entity may file an application for certification of its resources or technologies as eligible renewable energy resources and the Commission may approve, suspend, or deny the application.

Staff has completed its review of the application and any supplemental information filed by the applicant. Staff has determined that the proposed facility appears to satisfy the Commission's requirements for certification of the facility as a renewable energy facility. Staff recommends that this application be certified.
