Unfortunately, Republic Wind Farm, case 17-2295-EL-BGN, and Emerson Creek Wind Case #18-1607-EL-BGN, are striving to encroach on these birds and their nests. I feel that anything we can do to protect these birds is urgent and necessary.

The placing of commercial wind turbines any closer than two and a half miles to a nest is foolhardy. Please intervene for the sake of our wildlife, the residents of Seneca, and the adjacent counties.
