I am writing to request that you reject Case# 16-1871-EL-BGN, Icebreaker Wind Turbine, for the following reasons:

- 1. We don't need the power.
- 2. The siting of the wind turbines would not enable us to shutdown other power sources (coal or nuclear) because the wind doesn't blow all the time.
- 3. It is extremely expensive power to which Cleveland Public Power has committed. With the pandemic full upon us and the State reducing funding to many vital areas, including education, the public does not need a price increase for the power they purchase from CPP.
- 4. Building the turbine will not create additional manufacturing activity for Cleveland. They are produced where the wind is the greatest and the payback is the best.
- 5. Putting wind turbines in the lake is challenging and requires substantial subsidies.
- 6. A challenged community, such as NE Ohio, should not be funding basic work on whether economic energy can be developed on a lake which historically has thick ice.
- 7. Ohio has reduced its carbon footprint every year for the last 9 years.
- 8. The turbines proposed would contain 404 gallons of lubricants which threaten the drinking water for 11 million people.
