This letter of compliance is being filed pursuant to the requirements of Commission Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI on behalf of Nova Telephone Company, who is an issuing Carrier of the Ohio Intrastate Access Service Tariff (Issuing Carrier.)

The Issuing Carrier confirms their compliance with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's Entry May 1, 2018 in Case Number 10-2387-TP-COI. The Issuing Carrier's tariff, as referenced above, will change Intrastate Terminating Switched Access rates to mirror its Interstate Terminating Switch Access Rates and rate structure. Currently, these rates already mirror each other, in compliance with FCC rules set forth in 47 C.F. R. Sections 51.907, 51.909 and 51.911 as well as provisions with Section 61.2 of the same rules. Nova Telephone Company confirms that no intrastate tariff revisions are required at this time.
